**C. FOLLOW-UP ITEMS**

**1. Req. #2019-015: Mountain and Lemon Aves – Speeding / Traffic / Safety**

Resident requesting turn signal installation for north and southbound traffic on Mountain, NO LEFT TURN ON RED for north and southbound traffic on Mountain, and NO RIGHT TURN ON RED for westbound traffic on Lemon. Currently there is a NO RIGHT TURN ON RED sign posted for eastbound traffic on Lemon. The Police Department's records indicate the following ten-year collision history, at the Mountain and Lemon intersection:

The NO RIGHT TURN ON RED signage, for eastbound traffic on Lemon, was installed in 2013 / 2014. The NO RIGHT TURN ON RED signage, for westbound traffic on Lemon, was installed on Monday, August 19, 2019. *Closed.*

**2. Req. #2019-016: West Colorado Blvd alleyway at Magnolia – Traffic / Safety**

Resident requesting a convex mirror to be installed on the Southern California Edison (SCE) power pole for line-of-site safety when exiting the alleyway at Magnolia. Staff to reach out to SCE. *Closed.*

**3. Req. #2019-021: Alta Vista and Walnut Aves intersection (4-way Stop) – Traffic / Safety**

Resident requesting a 4-way Stop at the Alta Vista and Walnut intersection; currently a 2-way Stop. *Tracking sheet.*

**4. Req. #2019-022: 623 Hacienda Dr (speed cushions) – Speeding / Traffic / Safety**

Resident requesting a speed study and traffic calming on Hacienda. Traffic has been pushed to Hacienda from Bradbury and Terrado which have speed cushions. The Police Department conducted the following speed study:

Thursday, August 8 through Wednesday, August 14, 2019. The statistics indicate that 16,005 vehicles were tracked northbound. The 85<sup>th</sup> percentile of critical speed driven was 35.10 mph with the overall average speed of 31.14 mph driven. Southbound study to be completed and collision history to be provided for the intersection at Lemon and at Orange.

Police Department to conduct spot enforcement and work order to be created for centerline striping. *Closed.*

**5. Req. #2019-026: Mayflower and Palm Aves (4-way Stop) – Traffic / Safety**

Resident requesting a 4-way Stop at the Mayflower and Palm intersection; currently a 2-way stop. *Tracking sheet.*

**6. Req. #2019-028: Encino Ave at Genoa St (Stop sign on Encino at the northeast intersection) – Traffic / Safety**

Resident requesting a Stop sign on Encino at the north-east intersection of Encino and Genoa. Code Enforcement outreach for overgrown brush at 1718 Encino that is impeding line-of-site safety. *Closed.*

**7. Req. #2019-029: Magnolia and Maple Aves (4-way Stop) – Traffic / Safety**

Business employee requesting a 4-way Stop at the Magnolia and Maple intersection; currently a 2-way Stop. Gibson analysis and task order for a Stop warrant. *Carry over to upcoming meeting.*

**8. Req. #2019-030: Hacienda between Lemon and Orange Aves – Speeding / Traffic / Safety**

Resident requesting Stop sign installation on Hacienda at Lemon and Orange. Work order to be created for Stop sign and bar installation on Hacienda at Lemon and Orange.
